Improve the Group Decision-Making framework to eliminate bias and promote effective communication to ensure good decision fitness and proper risk management


# **Definition of "Group Decision-Making"**

- Framing the correct decision situations
- Centralised communication network + elements of trust and respect
- Generation of alternatives and opinions
- Group decision to be made as early as possible
- 100% consensus to be achieved in a group decision
